Instructions: Solve the subtraction problems below.

1	There are 985 cookies in the teacher's staff room. If 453 cookies are eaten, how many cookies are left?
2	Louis scores 1295 points in a game. He then loses 523 points. How many points does he have now?
3	Gina has 1680mL of soda. If she drinks 725mL, how much soda does she have left?
4	It is 1618 metres from Alan's house to the beach. If Alan has already walked 920 metres, how much further is it until he arrives at the beach?
5	A truck driver has to travel 862km. If he stops for a break after 216km, how many kilometres is left on his journey?





6	There are 2212 males and 1789 females at a concert. How many more males are there than females?	
7	A parking lot has 1520 spaces. If there are already 815 cars parked, how many empty spaces are left?	
8	A sushi restaurant has 9500 grams of rice at the beginning of the day. If 4238 grams of rice is needed during the day, how much rice will be left?	
9	If John has 5,614 stickers and Mary has 9,670 stickers, how many more stickers does John need to have the same amount as Mary?	
10	There are 4,687 books in a library. On Monday, 213 books were borrowed. How many books will be left in the library if no books have been returned yet and another 526 books are borrowed?	
11	A total of 6,992 people visited the museum this week. If 575 less people go to the museum every week, how many people will visit the museum two weeks from now?

1	Simon has 574 points in an arcade game. The high score is 1795 points. How many more points does Simon need to reach the high score?
2	A ship is carrying 3,521 oranges. If 410 oranges become rotten, how many oranges can still be eaten?
3	Jeffrey has \$1670 in savings. If he buys a toy for \$315, how much money will he have left?
4	Last weekend, Tom's restaurant had 3,019 customers. If 430 less people come this weekend, how many customers will the restaurant serve?
5	A store has 1,615 metres of ribbon. If it sells 460 metres, how much ribbon will it have left?



6	A water tank holds 1850L of water. If the rain fills it by 436L, how much water can the tank still hold?	
7	The Smith family needs to drive 1200km on their holiday. If they have already driven 913km, how much further must they drive?	
8	Kit and his friends have 1620 chocolate bars. Together, they eat 126 of them. How many bars do they have left?	
9	Bethany has spent 1268 minutes playing with her dolls and 725 minutes watching TV. How much more time has she spent with her dolls?	
10	Mrs Jones wins \$5500 from a contest. She spends \$490 on new clothes and \$58 on a haircut. How much money does she have left?	
11	Pam is reading a book with 1,419 pages. If she read 599 pages last week and 435 pages the week before, how many pages does she have left to read?
