




















Classifying Triangles

Triangle Classification			
<p>There are two ways of classifying triangles. We can either look at a triangle's side properties or angle properties.</p> <p><i>Note: Congruent means equal in size or length</i></p>			
	Equilateral	Isosceles	Scalene
CLASSIFYING BY SIDE	3 congruent sides	2 congruent sides	No congruent sides
			
	Acute	Right	Obtuse
CLASSIFYING BY ANGLE	3 angles $< 90^\circ$	1 angle = 90°	1 angle $> 90^\circ$
